- Company/Country Calendars \neq University Calendar
- Some internships have credit attached, others don't
- Internships can be too short or too long
- Internships may follow co-op semester
- May have ambiguously-related career goals
- Internship lists are never exhaustive
- May be offered late during registration
- Much more flexibility is needed

Ask students:

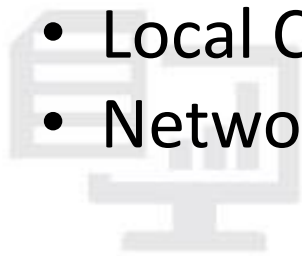
- What companies/organizations are doing interesting things in your field?

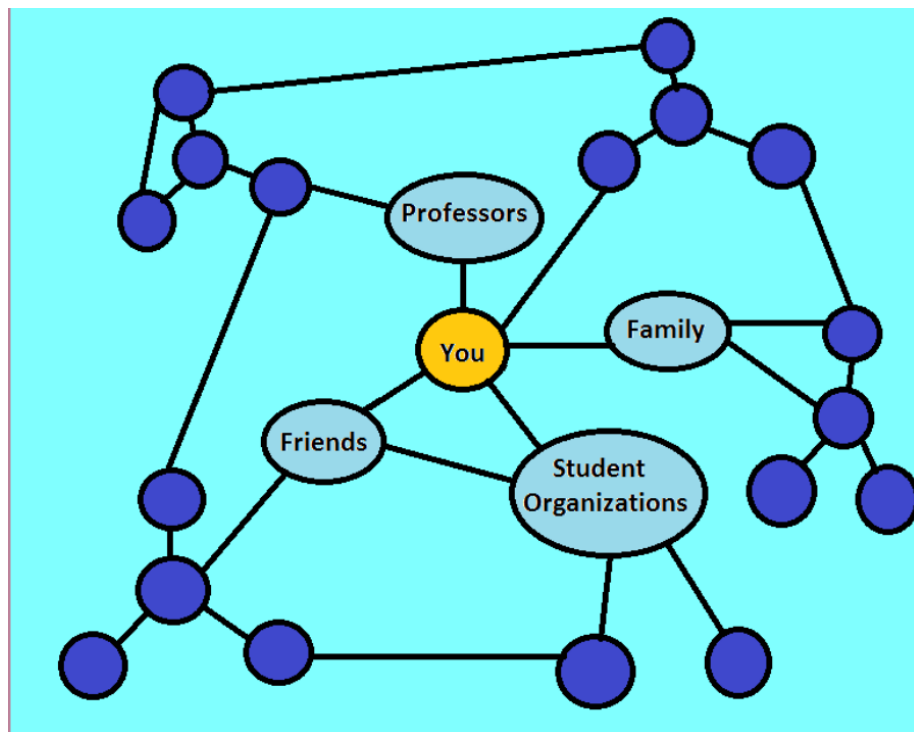
