Powerpoint based






NEW ORIENTATION MODEL

Online Pre-Arrival Orientation

Interactive 1 hour sessions held for groups of 100 students at a time

Ice Breaker, Scenarios, Kahoot, students broken into teams to 5-10











FUTURE PRE-ARRIVAL CONTENT

Student auto-added to mandatory online course after paying matriculation fee.

Hosted on BlackBoard.

Students given 5 weeks to complete course.

Interactive modules take students I hour to complete.

Students must score at least 80% to pass.



SCENARIO 1





While visiting San Francisco over summer break Harry's friends invite him to a house party. Everyone at the party is drinking and smoking pot.


Can Harry legally smoke marijuana?

CHALLENGES

Better retention of information

Gives students an opportunity to engage with ISSO staff

Students have several ways to get important information

Students become more familiar with our office and more likely to utilize our services

Untested with large groups

Requires high level of engagement from staff at a busy time of year

Restricted resources (locations, software, time in schedule)
