Regulatory Fast Facts STEM OPT

Remember: August 8, 2016

- Deadline for students currently on 17-month STEM OPT extension to apply for additional seven months
- Learn more in the STEM OPT Hub

What to know

- Lengthens STEM OPT extension from 17 to 24 months
- Form I-983, "Training Plan for STEM OPT Students"
- Transition plan
- DSO reporting requirements

Form I-515A Termination

- Notice to students "Intent to Terminate"
 - Sent to student, exchange visitor and/or their dependents
 - Recipient has 14 days to take action
 - Failure to comply will result in SEVIS record termination
- Additional information

SEVIS Enhancements

- SEVIS Release 6.27 July 2016
 - Form I-20 workflow improvements
 - Ability to mass register continuing students in real time
 - Alerts and student list improvements
 - New travel, visa and passport information page
- SEVIS Release 6.28 August 2016
 - SEVIS Broadcast Message archive



IN 2015, SEVP SET A NEW RECORD FOR EVENT ATTENDANCE IN A CALENDAR YEAR.






