




Scholarship Management at Tech

- Switched from a homegrown system to Terra Dotta (aka: Atlas)
- (Eventually) created a separate application cycle for scholarships
- Administer 6 different scholarships through 1 general application in Terra Dotta
- Use a mixture of questionnaires, materials, and the document center to manage the scholarship process
 - Collect thank you materials though Atlas (upload tool)

Scholarship Management at UGA

- Various Scholarship Applications Maintained in Terra Dotta Portal
 - o OGE General, Asia GA, Foundation Incentive, Oxford Endowed
- Utilize one general application for all OGE scholarships
- Separate applications for students that have been accepted
 - Moved over after decisions
- We provide scholarship committee members with reviewer status

Scholarship Management

- Create applications for your scholarships
 - Put them in "Scholarship" program group
- Utilize features to personalize application
 - Use the questionnaire features to add all application questions/essay portion.
 - Use the material submissions for students to upload financial aid documents, resumes, etc.
 - Use the signature documents to allow students to sign and agree to your scholarship terms
- Set deadlines and open applications
 - Withdraw students with incomplete applications after deadline
- After deadline, pull info into excel from a report
 - Provide information to scholarship committee members
- Change status and add tags as necessary

Terra Dotta Tips and Tricks

- Utilize Query Watches
 - Automatically inform eligible students
- Utilize Application Tags
 - National Scholarships, Multiple Deadlines
- Utilize Due Dates for Return Requirements
- Allow other departments to utilize TD for their scholarships
 - More centralized
- Use internal questionnaires
 - Track scholarship data or scholarship requirements
- Utilize learning content
 - Inform specific programs about scholarship opportunities
- When managing settings, be sure to un-tick box: override current system maximum of 1 applications per application cycle



Scholarship Resources

- Add a question about whether students receive a Pell Grant in general application
- Ask students if they want to apply for scholarships in the general application

Scholarship Resources

- Utilize campus listservs to distribute information about scholarships
- Post to platforms like OrgSync to reach students
- Get involved with organizations like NAFA
- Volunteer to read for national scholarships (like the Boren, CLS, Fund for Education, or Gilman)
- Utilize returned scholarship students to help promote
